High quality of life and good patient care without the need for liberty-restricting measures are important goals in the care sector. Great achievements have already been made here: in 2017, the Medizinischer Dienst des Spitzenverbandes Bund der Krankenkassen (medical services of the health insurance umbrella organisations) discovered that the use of liberty-restricting measures had significantly declined from 12.5 to 8.9% since 2013. Many establishments want to reduce this quota even further, to below 5%.

The comfortable beds from the Elvido range can help you in this endeavour. Tailor-made beds for many types of application can be created from the range of available models and flexible equipment options. Split safety sides or safety sides at the head end only, low-height beds for fall protection or the Out-of-Bed system offer an ideal balance between protection and mobility. 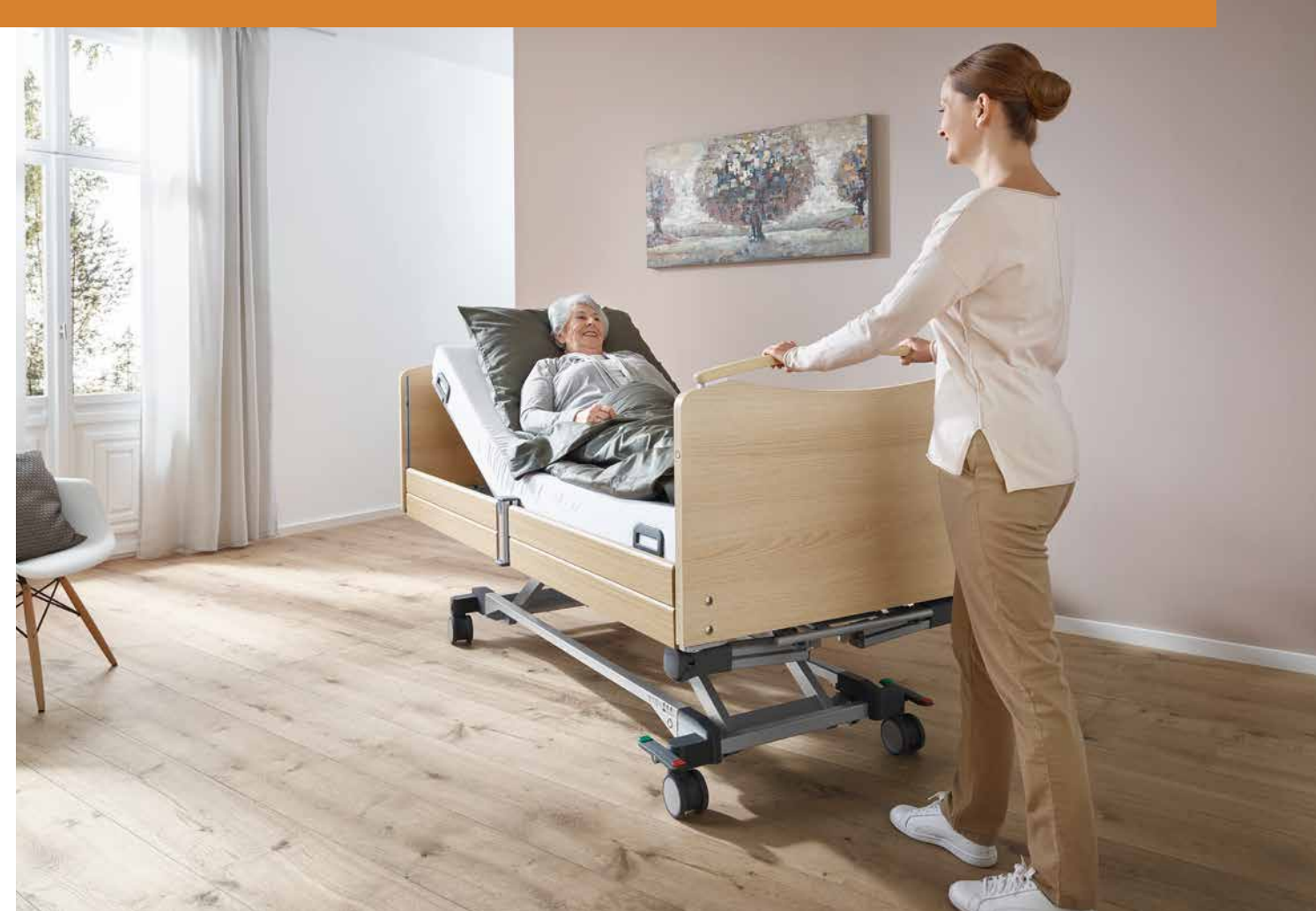
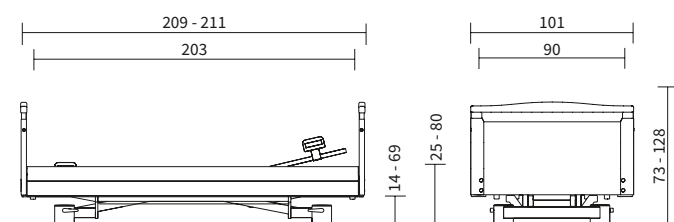
The versatile low-height bed to meet exacting requirements

The Elvido vervo is the model with the largest height adjustment range and is therefore also suitable for particularly intensive care situations. It offers the best possible protection from fall injuries and an optimal working height, even for tall care staff. Thanks to numerous optional features, this model can become a personalised, tailor-made bed.

- Height adjustment range: approx. 25 – 80 cm
- All residents, no matter how tall or short, have secure floor contact when leaving the bed; orientation and balance are heightened thanks to tactile perception by the soles of the feet

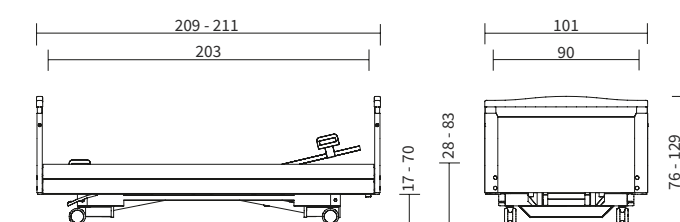

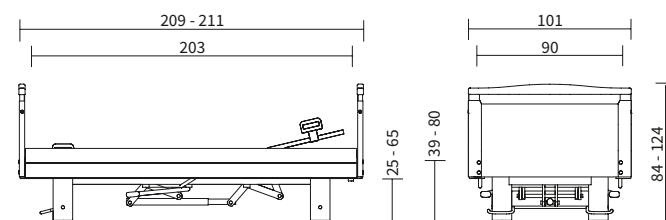

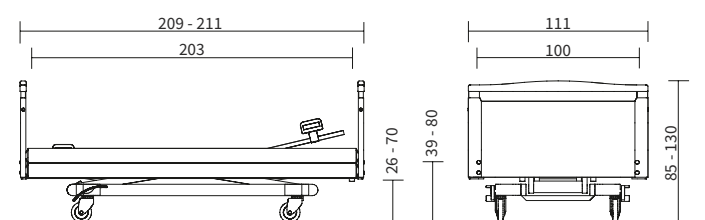

Chassis

with harmonious lines

The customisable wooden surround and the chassis give the Elvido range beds a cosy feel. The ends of its longitudinal struts are fitted with **four plastic covers** as standard. With their silver-grey colour, they exactly match the tone of the chassis. The covers encase mechanical parts and make the lines of the bed more harmonious. Additionally, the smoother surface can be cleaned even more easily and thoroughly. If required, the plastic elements can be removed without the use of tools.

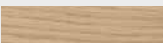
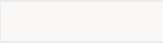
Upon request, more **complete covering** is available. The two plastic elements cover the entire front faces of the chassis and can be supplied in many homelike wood decor colours. Those who only need a covering for the headboard or the footboard can also just order a single element. The decor cover conceals the technical parts of the care bed, giving it a particularly homelike appearance. It is also easy to clean and remove.

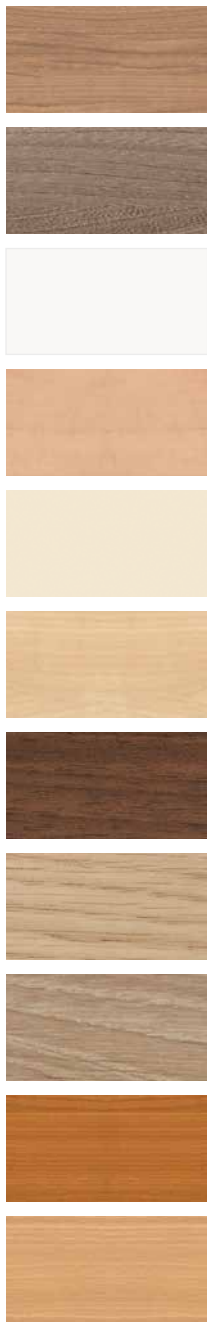
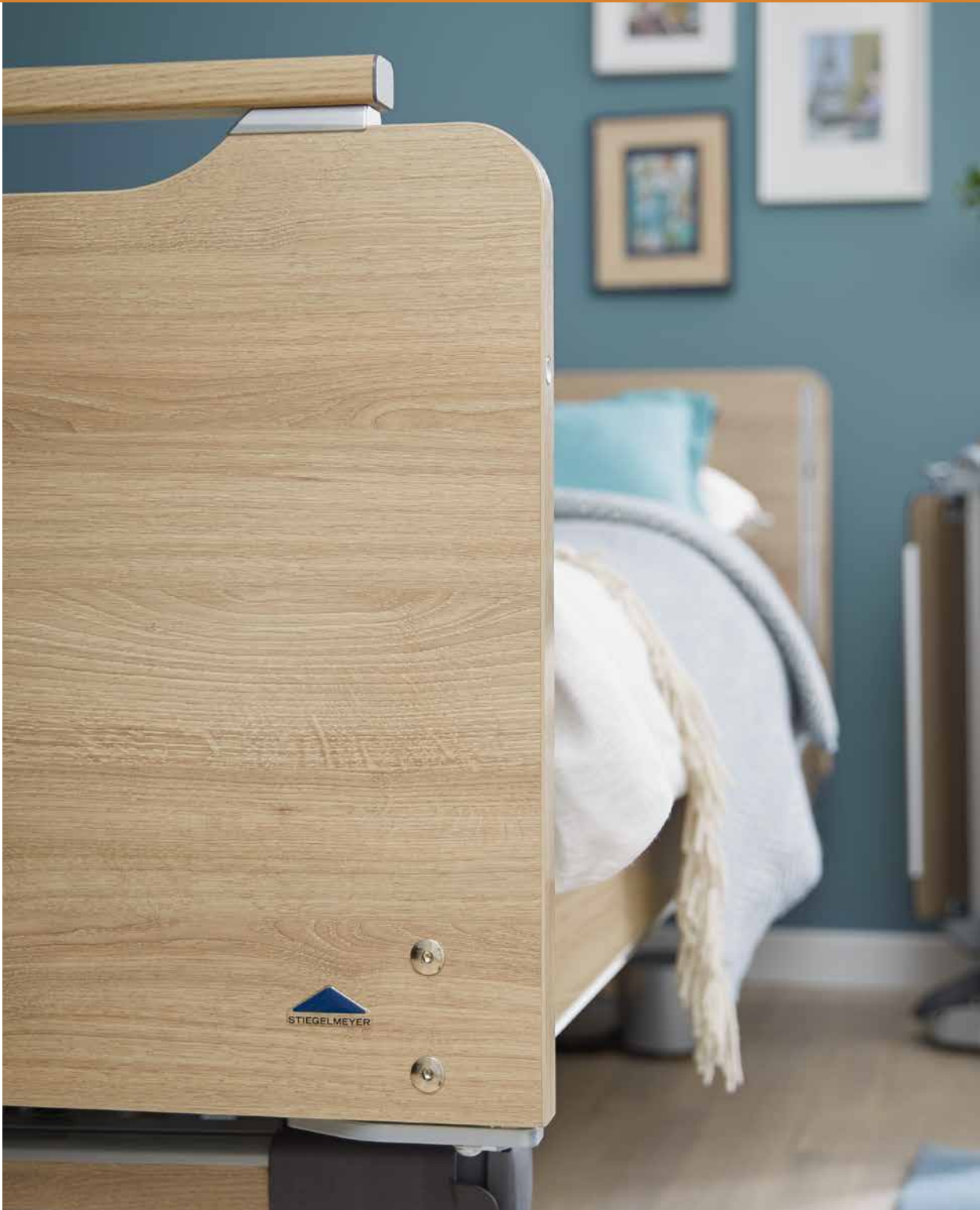

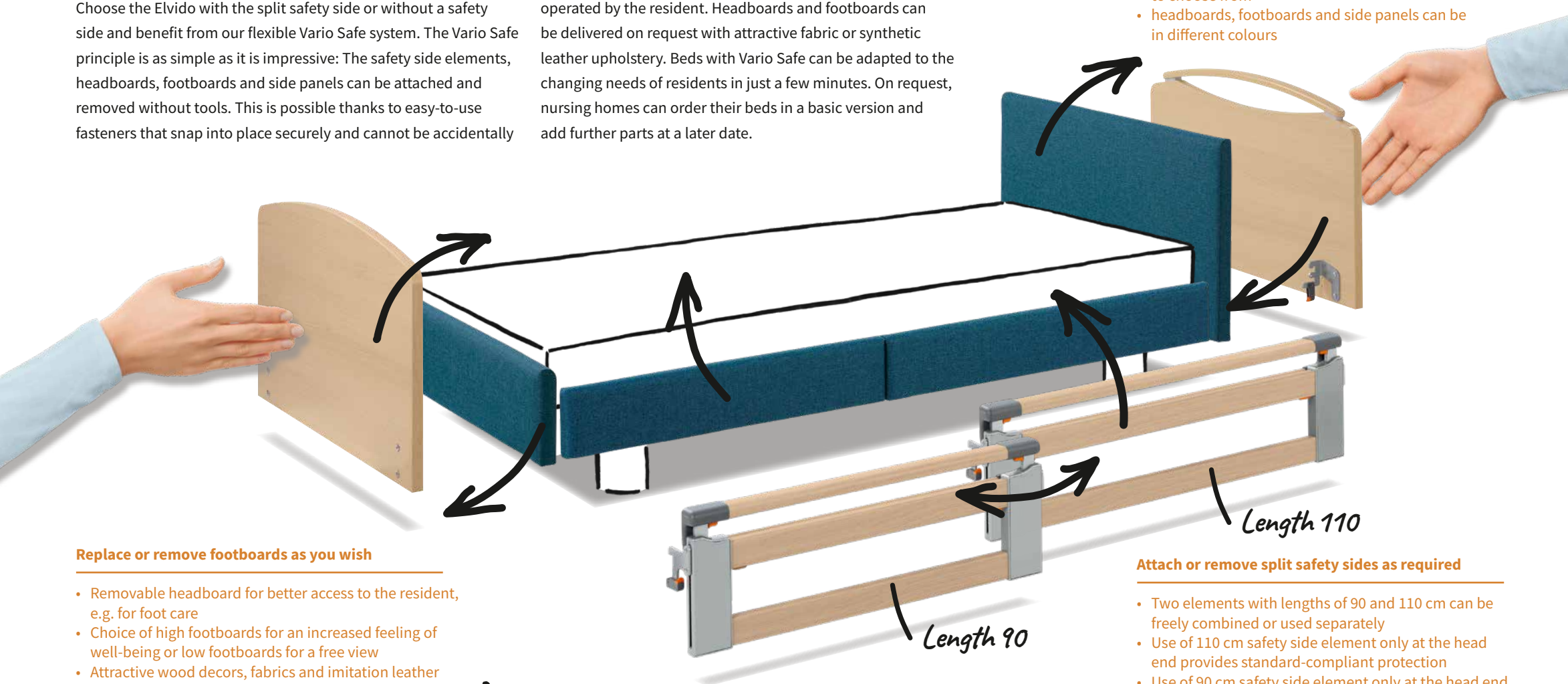

Elvido with Vario Safe – the best solution for standard-compliant safety

Choose the Elvido with the split safety side or without a safety side and benefit from our flexible Vario Safe system. The Vario Safe principle is as simple as it is impressive: The safety side elements, headboards, footboards and side panels can be attached and removed without tools. This is possible thanks to easy-to-use fasteners that snap into place securely and cannot be accidentally

operated by the resident. Headboards and footboards can be delivered on request with attractive fabric or synthetic leather upholstery. Beds with Vario Safe can be adapted to the changing needs of residents in just a few minutes. On request, nursing homes can order their beds in a basic version and add further parts at a later date.

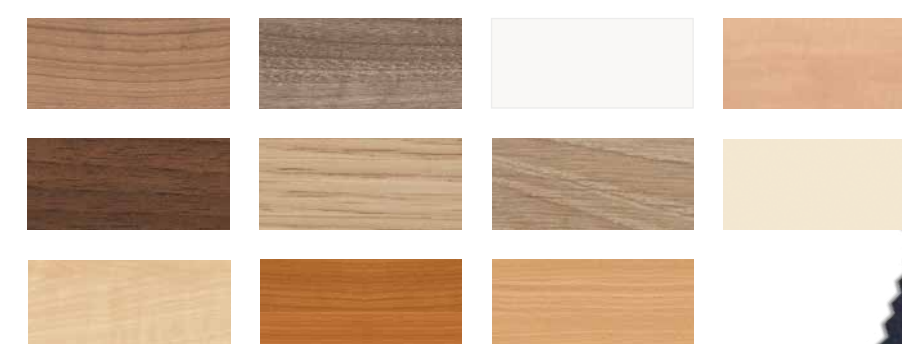

Safety sides

The ideal balance between protection and freedom

The Werdenfels approach is also reflected in the safety sides of the Elvido range. Two types of split safety sides are available for selected model variants. They ensure that residents can enjoy an optimum balance of protection and freedom.

The bars of the **combinable safety side** are attached to a central support which also serves as a mobilisation aid and provides the resident with a secure hold when standing up or sitting down. When no longer required, the support can be easily removed and stored in a holder under the bed. On request, the combinable safety side can be configured at the head end only - together with the centre support it still covers more than 50% of the mattress base and meets the requirements of the relevant standards. As its name suggests, it can be combined with a continuous safety side on the other side of the bed.

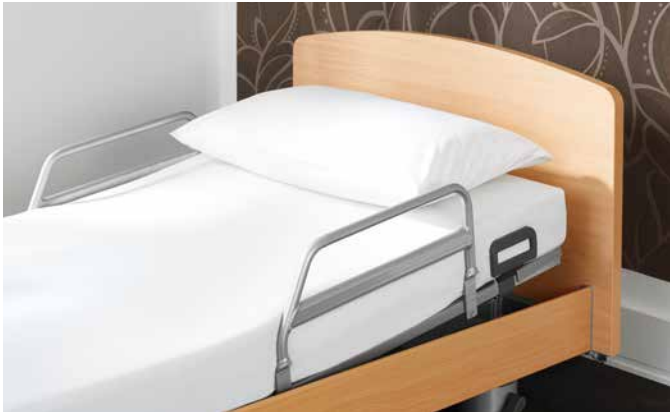
The telescopic elements of the **split safety side** can easily be raised in two stages. In the first stage, the resident is provided with an orientation aid, in the second stage, complete protection. The 110 cm long elements at the head end of this model also satisfy the requirements of standards when used by themselves. Homelike panels can be attached to the foot end if desired. The telescopic split safety side is attached using the Vario Safe system.

The standard **full-length safety side** offers maximum protection and, at a height of 41 cm, is highly suitable for using with an anti-decubitus mattress. For independent users, such as those in rehabilitation facilities, the **EasyGrip** model is a good alternative – slender rails at the end give better orientation. All Elvido beds are available without safety sides as well.



- ◀ The safety side at the head end always leaves enough room for getting in and out of bed unhindered.
- ▼ The centre support of the split safety sides also serves as a practical mobilisation aid.

- ▲ The full-length safety sides supplied as standard offer maximum protection against falls.
- ▼ The safety side can be set diagonally as an orientation aid for the resident without restricting his or her mobility or view of the room.



- ▲ EasyGrip is a rail that gives the resident a better feel for the dimensions of the bed and also provides support when leaving the bed.

- ▲ The telescopic split safety side flexibly adjusts to suit all needs.



Split safety sides

Individual safety in every function

The Vario Safe system is available with the Libra care bed and with the Elvido for the split safety side. This enables very **precise settings** to be made that are closely tailored to the changing needs of the resident.

The individual elements of the split safety side can be **raised in two stages**. In the first stage, they provide the occupant with support and orientation, and in the second stage, they provide reliable protection. A diagonal position also ensures a good feeling of safety. If the patient is able to leave the bed whenever they like, we recommend only **raising the safety sides at the head end**. In this case, the foot-end elements can also be removed and replaced by homelike panels. The streamlined wood-metal appearance of the safety side ensures excellent hygiene properties.

The split safety side can be raised and locked securely into place in **one easy movement**. The elements are lowered again by pressing the release buttons under the bars.

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Standard-compliant protection

- In a mattress base measuring 200 cm, the **split safety side** on each side consists of a 110 cm and a 90cm long element.
- These elements can be used **interchangeably** at the head and foot ends.
- If the 110 cm element is attached at the head end, it covers **more than 50% of the mattress base** and is therefore also a standard-compliant safety side on its own.
- The 90 cm element does not offer standard-compliant protection, but it provides **support and plenty of room** to get in and out of bed.
- If the **bed extension** is used, two 110 cm elements can be attached.



▲ If an object is in the way when the bed is lowered, the split safety side gives way flexibly.



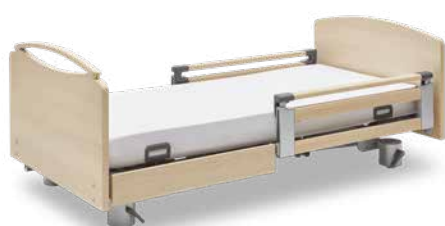

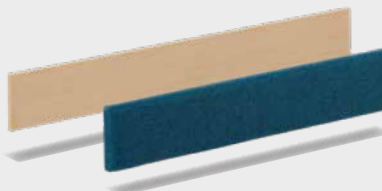

Low-height beds for fall prevention

Mobilisation and ergonomics

Always at the right height for ease of movement

Getting up and getting into bed are particularly problematic moments in the day of a person in need of care. On the one hand, we want the resident to make these movements independently for as long as this is possible. On the other hand, these are precisely the situations that involve a high risk of falling. Cognitive limitations, reduced muscle mass, a weaker sense of balance or side effects of medicines can unsettle older people.

With their large, **stepless height adjustment range**, the Elvido range beds assist residents and carers alike. Falls can never be prevented with absolute certainty, but, particularly with the low-height Elvido vervo bed, the risk of injury at the lowest position is significantly reduced.

This often means that liberty-restricting measures such as restraint systems or full-length safety sides can be dispensed with as a result.

The optimal ergonomic **height for getting in and out of bed** can be adjusted as required using the handset (or the pump pedal in the case of the Elvido rega). For many people, this is below 40 cm – the feet then make good contact with the floor and the proprioceptors are stimulated. At the **maximum height** of approximately 80 cm, care staff can work with a straight back and thus protect their health.

◀ The large height-adjustment range allows care staff to work without putting strain on their backs.



◀ The hygiene mattress base is easy to remove and thoroughly clean by hand.

▼ If the use of patient restraints is unavoidable, the cut-outs in the hygiene mattress base can be used for securing belts.



Mattress bases

The basis for healthy and restful sleep



▲ Hygiene mattress base

The Elvido **hygiene mattress base**, supplied as standard, makes thorough bed reprocessing particularly easy. Deep venting slits in the polypropylene promote a healthy microclimate in the bed and beneficial sleep. All types of special mattress can usually be used without an underlay mattress, so that the safety sides are still high enough to ensure proper protection.



▲ Comfort mattress base – flexibly supported base components with pivot springs

There is also a **comfort mattress base** available, which has even better characteristics. This comprises 30 flexibly supported base components with 80 pivot springs of varying stiffness. The comfort mattress base adjusts exactly to the contours of the body and improves the pressure-reducing effect of the mattress. The comfort mattress base is slightly higher than traditional models, so you will need to check whether the protection height of the safety sides is sufficient in combination with your mattress.



▲ In the 24-volt system, a transformer plug supplies a safety extra-low voltage at the socket.

Energy-saving and safe

Modern drive systems

A high level of safety, significantly reduced electricity costs and effortless operation: The optional 24-volt system is an attractive choice for the Elvido bed.

A transformer plug supplies a 24-volt **safety extra-low voltage** directly at the power socket. There are therefore no components carrying 230 volts anywhere in the vicinity of the resident, which means that he or she enjoys a higher level of safety.

Power consumption drops by up to 93%. There is a floor-mounted power pack available to use the 24-volt system with international mains plugs.

The Elvido is equipped with a reliable **230-volt drive system** as standard. With matching selectable mains plugs, it is therefore ready for international use wherever it is needed.



For the 230-volt system, 6 types of mains plugs are available, which comply with various international standards.

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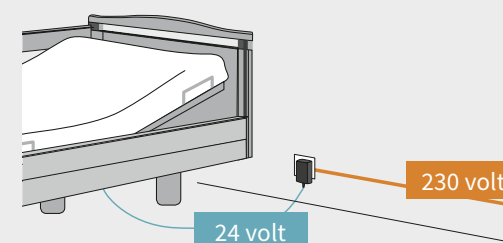

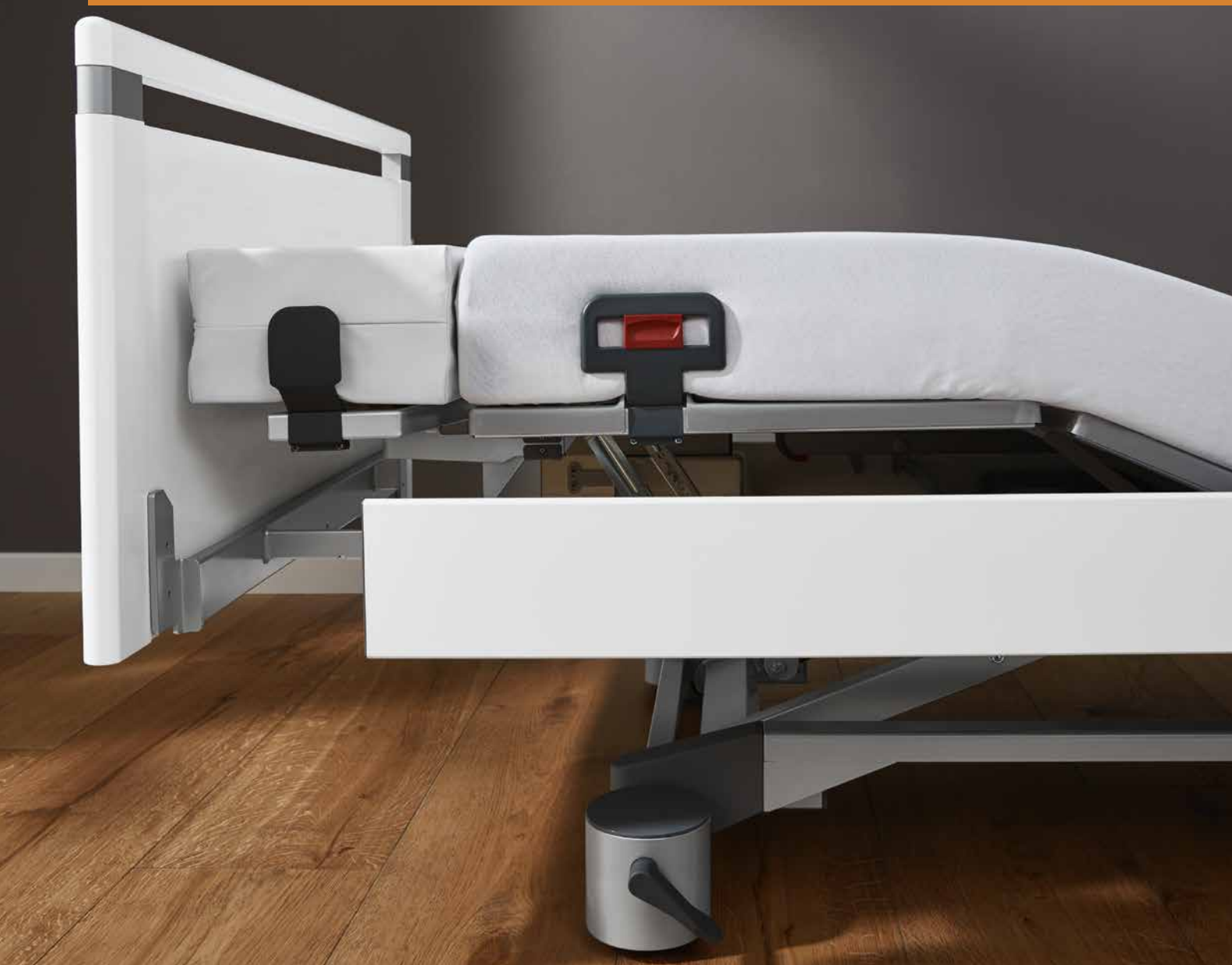

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Strong advantages

- The optional rechargeable battery makes the care bed independent of the mains power supply in an emergency



- ▲ If the bed does not have safety sides along the entire length, then the integrated bed extension can be used without any further accessories. The gap in the side panels at the foot end is standard-compliant. It can be closed with filler pieces, if desired.



- ▲ With the telescopic bed extension, the bars and side panels can be simply pulled out to extend them.



- ▲ Longer safety side bars and filler pieces for the side panels are available for the integrated bed extension, if required.

Bed extension

More room and comfort for residents in just a few easy steps

The user-friendly bed extension for the Elvido range improves the comfort of tall residents. All of the models are equipped with an integrated 20 cm **extension of the bed frame as standard** (exception: Elvido rega). If the bed has no safety sides or has safety sides only at the head end, this extension can be used, whenever required, without any further fittings. If safety sides are needed along the entire length of the bed, longer bars can be supplied.

The optional **telescopic bed extension** is even more convenient. This allows the bed frame, safety side bars and side panels to be easily extended without using any tools.

We offer two options for extending the mattress base. The first is a **mattress piece** that always remains securely fixed in its position at the foot end. The second is an **extension of the lower leg rest**, which moves with the leg rest when adjustments are made. This allows even tall people to use the bed in a health-promoting position with the legs raised.



- ▲ A mattress piece, which remains fixed in position, can be inserted when the mattress base is extended.



- ▲ The optional extension for the lower leg rest moves together with the leg rest when moves together are made.

- ▲ The lower leg rest extension can be hooked into place, without needing to use tools. A corresponding mattress piece is available.



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EasyCare relieves the strain on care staff

- The LCD handset contains **three control levels**: for residents, care staff and technicians.
- Care staff can **block certain adjustment functions for the residents**.
- With the **EasyCare** function, these functions can be used at the care staff level without changing the blocking status for the resident. This saves care staff a lot of time and increases the level of safety.



The LCD handset has just three buttons and an illuminated display, giving all users optimum control of the bed.



▲ The standard handset uses intuitive pictograms to indicate the different adjustment options.

Innovative operating concept

Handset for customised requirements

The Venta is operated using one of a selection of handsets. The most convenient version is the optional **LCD handset** with only 3 buttons, EasyCare and a backlit display. It has 3 control levels: for residents, care staff and technicians. The levels can be unlocked and set with the help of a magnet on the bed.

The **standard handset** displays all the adjustment positions with simple pictograms. The button rows can be selectively locked. A separate **Trendelenburg handset** is available for quickly moving the bed into the Trendelenburg position; this ensures that the resident cannot mistake this function for the reverse-Trendelenburg position.

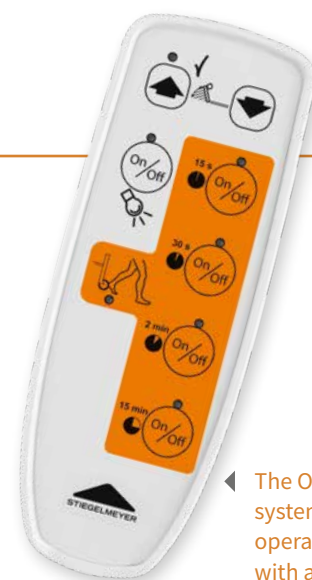

e-help

Digital assistance systems

Digital assistance systems are a modern solution for reducing liberty-depriving measures, protecting residents and at the same time supporting care staff, especially during night shifts. Under the name “e-help”, Stiegemeyer is constantly developing these systems further.

The focus here is on the **Out-of-Bed system**. A load sensor in the backrest registers when a resident gets out of bed. The system also has an optional feature that immediately switches on an under bed light or the reading lamp for better orientation in the dark. After a specified time interval, it notifies the care staff via the existing in-house call system.



The Out-of-Bed system can be operated very easily with a handset.



If the resident leaves the bed, the system notifies the care staff via a signal light in the corridor, for example, or an acoustic alarm in the duty room.

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The Out-of-Bed system

- Orientation with the optional under bed light
- Significantly reduced risk of falls at night without the need for restraints
- Care staff are notified after a set time of between 15 seconds and 15 minutes, which avoids frequent false alarms immediately after someone gets out of bed
- Immediate support for residents who are susceptible to falls

Tailoring the Elvido to your taste

All Elvido models can be transformed into tailor-made beds using original accessories for the highest level of comfort and to meet very specific requirements. The central focus is on improving safety for the resident, ensuring a higher quality of everyday life and protecting the beds from damage.



▲ All-round protection against impact injuries can be provided for residents by fitting protective covers on the headboard, footboard, safety sides and the mobilisation support. This also prevents limbs from reaching between the bars of the safety sides.



▲ The protective cover for the full-length safety sides can move up and down with the bars.



▲ The patient lifting pole helps the resident get comfortably positioned in the bed.



▲ The wall deflection roller protects the bed and the walls during horizontal and vertical movements.



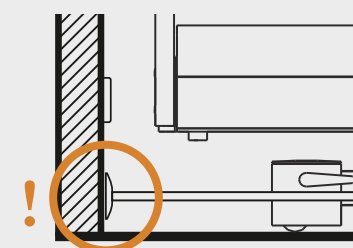
▲ Fall protection mats made of 3 cm thick composite foam are recommended for maximum prevention of fall injuries.



▲ The wall spacer protects the bed, walls and furniture from collision damage.
