Where space is at a premium, a narrower 80 cm mattress base variant is available, instead of 90 cm. 


Motorised variants


Deka versions offering motorised adjustment of the bed provide many comfort features and great safety in the clinical routine. Here, too, there are many versions to choose from: Possible versions include a single motor for the backrest, 2 motors for backrest and height adjustment and the 3-motor variant, which includes an additional motor for moving the thigh rest.








- ▲ The Trendelenburg position and reverse-Trendelenburg positions can be quickly and safely activated with a lever.

▲ On the alternative handset, the functional groups are locked and unlocked with the aid of a locking box in the linen holder.


















Mechanical variants


Electricity costs money and is not always on hand at the place of use. The mechanical version of the Deka makes the operator of the bed independent of an electricity supply. At the same time, so many adjustments are possible with virtually no effort that it is no problem at all to obtain a comfortable lying position for the patient and an ergonomic waist-level working height for nursing staff.


- Back-friendly height adjustment by pressing the hydraulic pump

▲ The bed is equipped with a sliding backrest as standard to prevent any unpleasant shear forces for the patient.



▲ The Deka optionally provides a comfortable reverse-Trendelenburg position as well as a Trendelenburg position in case of an emergency. Both positions are set mechanically using a lever at the foot end.



▲ The Deka moves through its large height adjustment range of 43 to 83 cm with the aid of a pedal that nursing staff can easily reach with their foot at any time.


Reliable basic care




